GENERAL RULES

All recitals will be held on Sundays at Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church in Bethesda, MD., with the exception of the Adult Recital and Adult Musicales. Students should enter front door of the church. The ramp door, which is handicap accessible, can be used before 2:00 p.m. and between 3:15 and 3:30 p.m.

Students must report to the Chairman at least 10 minutes before the program begins. No changes will be made to the program. Students are expected to remain for the entire recital; any student who cannot do so should not be scheduled to play.

Please Note:

All recitals, musicales and honors are held in recital format.

Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, so please send in applications early.

Eligibility: Non-professional/non-collegiate instrumental and vocal adult students who wish to play for one another in an informal setting and receive a judge's critique of their performance. If the recital program is too full, the chair reserves the right to limit the maximum number of students per teacher.

Special Rules:

- A time limit of eight minutes per performer. Exact timing is required.
- Playing from memory is not required.
- Those who wish to play longer must first check with the chair.
- Maximum number of participants, 8.
