Eligibility: Open to instrumental and voice students of all ages who are studying with a WMTA member in good standing.

The Anthony Chanaka Festival was created to honor the memory of our long-time WMTA member and treasurer. This bi-annual event alternates with the Baroque Festival.

Repertoire: Any solo or ensemble music written by a composer of the Classical Era. (*A Classical composer is defined as one whose birth and death dates fall between 1720 and 1828*).

Time Limits: Each performance may include one or two pieces, limited to a total of eight minutes. *Each movement of a sonata or sonatina is considered to be one piece.*

Special Rules:

- Pianists may not program simplified arrangements. No method book pieces are allowed. Bowed string, wind and brass instrument arrangements and transcriptions are permitted at the elementary level only.
- Guitar arrangements and transcriptions are permitted at all levels.
- Piano solo works must be performed by memory.
- The following may perform with score: piano duets; strings, wind and brass solos; and ensembles.
- Incomplete and illegible applications will be returned.
- Students must provide the judges with scores of their piece(s) in order to receive a critique. For use of photocopies or music from another source refer to the General Rules for WMTA events.
- Timings of the piece(s) must be exact, to facilitate timing of the recitals.
- Performers must provide their own accompanist.
- Teachers of participating students should be prepared to assist the chairman for this event.

This event is in recital format. All entrants will receive a critique and a certificate of participation.
