Repertoire Requirements:

- **Time Limits:** *Elementary - 6 minutes; Intermediate - 8 minutes; Advanced and Adult - 10 minutes.*
- Students may perform *one* concerto movement originally written for piano and orchestra.
- No piano duo literature is permitted.
- The Elementary and Intermediate repertoire of concerti listed below are *suggestions* regarding leveling, not required repertoire.
- For the Advanced level, any concerto from the standard concerto literature is acceptable.
- Please contact one of the competition chairs if you have any questions about repertoire.

- Due to time constraints, students who exceed the specified time limit will be stopped.
- Teachers of participating students should be prepared to help out on the Festival day, as adjudicators, time keepers or monitors as needed.

This is a non-competitive WMTA event. All students will receive a certificate of participation. Judges' comments will be mailed to teachers.

The ConcertoFest is in recital format and is open to the public.
