

RECITALS

GENERAL RULES

All recitals will be held on Sundays at Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church in Bethesda, MD., with the exception of the Adult Recital and Adult Musicales. Students should enter front door of the church. The ramp door, which is handicap accessible, can be used before 2:00 p.m. and between 3:15 and 3:30 p.m.

Students must report to the Chairman at least 10 minutes before the program begins. No changes will be made to the program. Students are expected to remain for the entire recital; any student who cannot do so should not be scheduled to play.

Please Note:

All recitals, musicales and honors are held in recital format.

For use of photocopies or music from other sources refer to the General Rules for WMTA events.

Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, so please send in applications early.

JUDGED RECITALS

Dates: October 25, 2009, November 15, 2009, February 7, 2010, March 14, 2010, April 18, 2010, at 3:30 p.m.
The November 15 recital is limited to students age 12 and under.

Place: Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church, 6601 Bradley Blvd., Bethesda, MD.

Postmark or hand-delivery deadline: Two weeks before the recital date.

Fee: Recital fee of \$17.00 must accompany each application.

Repertoire Requirements: Simplified arrangements are not permitted but concert transcriptions are acceptable. All entrants must perform solo pieces and concertos from memory. The only exception to this rule is chamber music, such as a string quartet or a duo. Performers must provide an original score of each work to be performed.

Eligibility: Students through the high school senior year. *Anyone selected for Honors last year is ineligible to play this year.* Only students with successful recital experience should be presented in a Judged Recital. Please Note: In order to be considered for Honors, a student *must* be present for the entire recital.

Time Limits: A teacher may present two students at each recital, each student not exceeding six minutes playing time, or one student not exceeding eight minutes playing time.

Awards: All participants will receive judges' comments. Several students from each recital will be chosen to play in the Honors Recital.
