Repertoire Requirements: Play four selections, one from each group:

1. Baroque: Any composition from the Baroque Period and any transcriptions from a Baroque composer are allowed. For example: a Bach Prelude and Fugue, two sonatas by Scarlatti or Soler, a Bach-Busoni transcription, three movements of a suite by Bach, Handel, Couperin.
2. Classical: A movement of a Classical sonata by Haydn, Clementi, Beethoven, Mozart or early Schubert.
3. Romantic: Any composition from the Romantic period.
4. Contemporary/Impressionistic: A composition from either the Impressionistic period, or a piece written in the 20th or 21st century.
