Fees: Junior Division: \$35.00 Senior Division: \$50.00

Eligibility: The Junior Division is open to elementary and middle school students as of the competition date. The Senior Division is open to any student nineteen years of age or younger currently enrolled in any high school, middle school, or elementary school in the Washington metropolitan area.

For questions regarding eligibility, application and competition information, including use of photocopies or music from other sources, please refer to General Rules for WMTA events.

Note: The Novik is a two-tiered competition with Preliminaries and Finals. Applicants must provide their own accompanist at each level of the competition. The accompanist may be anyone *other than the student's own teacher*.

Awards: The first place prize of the Senior Division shall be a monetary award and/or a performance of the concerto entered with a Washington area orchestra. A second place monetary prize shall be awarded as well as an honorable mention. In the Junior Division, only monetary prizes will be awarded. Prizes may be withheld at the discretion of the judges.

Note: First place winners are not eligible to enter the same division of the Competition a second time.
