GENERAL RULES

All recitals will be held on Sundays at Bradley Hills Presbyterian Church in Bethesda, MD., with the exception of the Adult Recital and Adult Musicales. Students should enter front door of the church. The ramp door, which is handicap accessible, can be used before 2:00 p.m. and between 3:15 and 3:30 p.m.

Students must report to the Chairman at least 10 minutes before the program begins. No changes will be made to the program. Students are expected to remain for the entire recital; any student who cannot do so should not be scheduled to play.

All recitals, musicales and honors are held in recital format.

Applications are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis, so please send in applications early.

Fees: Recital fee of \$12.00 must accompany each application.

Postmark or hand-delivery deadline: Two weeks before the recital date.

Repertoire Requirements: Literature pieces are preferred, but teaching solos and tasteful, simplified arrangements are acceptable. All entrants must perform solo pieces from memory. The only exception is chamber music.

Time Limits: A teacher is allowed 12 minutes playing time for participating student(s). Exact timing is required.

Eligibility: Students through the high school senior year interested in broadening their performance experience and musical fulfillment at all levels of advancement. Although prior performance experience is not necessary, students should have given good demonstration of performance ability in a studio situation.

Awards: Students will receive certificates of participation.
